**Pre-Registration
March 1–March 31, 2007**

Berkeley residents who register by March 31, 2007 will be given priority. All residents must show proof of residency (i.e. utility bill).

You can register Monday-Friday, 9:00 A.M.–4:00 PM at the Recreation Office, 1947 Center St., First Floor, or you can register by mail (see registration form).

Non-Residents: Applications will be accepted but not confirmed until Berkeley resident registrations are processed.

All new players moving to new age levels must attend one of the following try-outs to be assigned to a team.

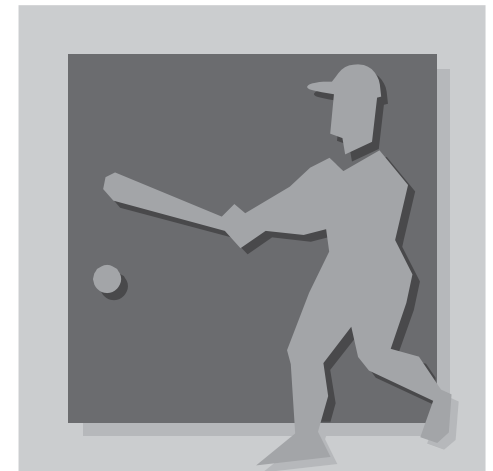

LEAGUE INFORMATION

General Information

- All players receive a shirt and cap.
- Players are assigned by coaches to teams on a city-wide basis (not by choice or request).
- Returning players in same age group return to previous year's team.
- Players going to new age group must attend tryout.
- Weekday and Saturday games (limited practices after games begin).
- Game days assigned by age divisions.
- Team assignments are final.

Instructional League

Ages 5-6

Developing catching, batting, fielding, and base running skills emphasized. Special games played on Friday.

Ages 7-8*

*(6 year olds may play if they have participated in Instructional League)

A rubber baseball is used. There is no official scoring during games. Each child must participate. There are awards for all participants.

Jr. Bantam League

Ages 9-12

This league plays games using officials, HARD BASEBALL, youth baseball rules and special league rules. Players must play one inning in each game. Awards are given for first and second place teams only determined by play-offs. Players are assigned to teams by the coaches. Placement on teams is on a citywide basis. All placements are final.

Senior Bantam

Ages 13-15

This league plays games using officials, HARD BASEBALL, youth baseball rules. The only special league rule is that players must play one inning in each game. Awards are given to teams making the playoffs. New players must attend try-outs.
